Beaches

Top beaches near Pollenca

Beautiful beaches and secret coves



Cala San Vicente Beach

Find a perfect spot on the dramatic rocks that make up the small bay and dangle your feet in the crystal-clear water. This is one of our favourite beaches as it's one of the best snorkelling areas, but due to the nature of the cove it can get feel very crowded, so aim to arrive early! Cala san Vicenc as it's known to the locals is split into 4 parts: Cala Barques, is the largest and considered the main beach. A small path leads to the middle, smaller beach, Cala Clara, which can be more crowded as it is in front of a hotel. The third beach, Cala Molins, is very popular due to its very white sand and its popular spot for families with small children. The fourth beach, if you continue driving, is a small stoney cove at Cala Carbo. Not great for sunbathing or small children, it is very rugged and excellent for snorkelling and diving. Although the first three beaches are fairly child-friendly, please be aware this is the open sea, it gets deep quite quickly and occasionally there is a warning flag visible for strong undertow or jellyfish.

Puerto Pollensa/ Port de Pollenca Beach

The main beach at Puerto Pollensa is almost one and a half kilometres long and very wide. The popular and well-loved golden sands offer calm waters with plenty of sunbeds dotted along the way, a backdrop of shops and restaurants, and impressive views of the mountains and the Formentor peninsula. Head past the marina you will find yourself on the famous "Pine Walk" and a lovely long stretch of very narrow beach - called Albercuix beach, ideal for paddling, flanked with pine trees. In the opposite direction (toward Alcudia) you'll find a stretch of beach dotted with Pine trees and picnic tables known as Llenaire, an area very popular with the locals, especially on weekends. Wind and kite surfing is very popular on Pollensa beach, thanks to its position in the Bay, with its favourable winds. Watersports and sailing are also popular, and you can hire dinghies, pedalos, windsurfs and motorboats.

Parking: There is a free public free public car park, 5 mins walk from Mar Calma (almost walk through the Square to it).

Ideal for: Families, couples, groups who want to enjoy an easy & convenient day at the beach. Windsurfing & water-sports available.

Formentor Beach

This strip of powdery white sand turquoise waters flanked with Pine trees, is so stunning you'd be forgiven for thinking you'd just landed in the Caribbean! Home to the world-famous 5-star **Formentor Hotel**, this beach is a must-see. The beach is very popular with tourists who also make their way north for the scenic views at **Cap de Formentor**, the farthest point on the island that ends in a lighthouse. Playa de Formentor is divided into three sections, each of which has its own set prices for lounge chairs and umbrellas, and prices can get quite high in peak summer months. The narrow beach can get quite crowded, however, the shallow water is great for small children. Some areas of the beach can get rocky but otherwise, it's easily accessible. There are some water activities for hire such as paddle boats, windsurfing and SUP equipment, but it's not too overwhelming with noise or equipment, leaving plenty of room for swimmers and snorkelers. There is a couple of small souvenir shops, a cafe and a restaurant as well, however, be aware that you are a captive market here and prices are higher and quality is lower.

You can also reach the beach by ferry boat, which runs regularly to Formentor Beach from Puerto Pollensa, ask at any of the boat hire booths about buying tickets. Or hire a boat for a couple of hundred Euros for half a day even if you don't have a license.

Markets

Top Traditional Markets



Pollenca Market – Sunday 8am to 1pm

Arguably the most important market on the island, every Sunday the serene streets and square of Pollensa become the vibrant stage for over 3,000 stalls.

From 8am until 1pm you can find stalls crammed with food, crafts, shoes, clothes, plants in the Plaça Major (main square) and Ca Les Monnares Square squeezing out to surrounding streets. Make sure you get there early as thousands from all over the island come to visit this market. Haggle like a professional to secure the best bargains. All the local shops are also open, so you'll be in for a real shopping extravaganza!

Puerto Pollensa – Wednesday 8am to 1.30pm

The market in Port de Pollença / Puerto Pollensa is held every Wednesday, between 8am and 1.30pm, in Miquel Capllonch Square, next to the Mare de Déu del Carme church. The market is fairly new, having started in 1986. However, it has grown from 50/60 stalls to 197, among which you can find fruits and vegetables, crafts, clothes, shoes and gifts stand out, plants and other typical products from the island.

Alcudia Markets – Tuesdays & Sundays 9am to 2pm

Situated beside the city walls, but spreading through the picturesque narrow streets during tourist season, Alcudia Market starts at about 9am and carries on usually until 2pm-ish. There are two sections to this market. The main one is dedicated to local farmers selling their products; and the second section has plenty of stalls selling absolutely everything: shoes, bags, handbags, football shirts, souvenirs...you name it... We love to walk around the market in the morning and then grab some tapas for lunch in one of the many restaurants in the town centre.

Monday: Calvià, Lloret de Vistalegre, Manacor, Caimari, Montuïri.

Tuesday: Alcúdia, Artà, Campanet, Porreres and Santa Margalida.

Wednesday: Andratx, Capdepera, Felanitx, Petra, Port de Pollença, Santanyí, Selva, Sencelles, Sineu, Vilafranca de Bonany and Colònia de Sant Jordi (middles).

Thursday: Ariany, Campos, S'Arenal, Consell, Inca, Pòrtol, Sant Llorenç de Cardassar, Ses Salines, Sant Joan, Lloseta and Deià.

Friday: Alaro, Algaida, Binissalem, Can Picafort, Lluçmajor, Maria de la Salut, Pont d'Inca, Son Servera and Sa Cabaneta.

Saturday: Búger, Bunyola, Cala Rajada, Campos, Costitx, Esporles (first Saturday of the month), Palma de Mallorca, Santanyí, Sóller, Santa Eugènia and Santa Margalida.

Sunday: Alcúdia, Consell (Flohmarkt), Felanitx, Lluçmajor, Muro, Pollença, Porto Cristo, Santa Maria del Camí, Valldemossa and Sa Pobla.

Top 4 hikes



Walk to Puig de Maria

Although it is only a small mountain (330m), the Puig de Maria has a very important place in the culture and traditions of Pollença. After a short but steep ascent to the top, there is a wonderful view over the bays of Pollença and Alcudia, making this one of the most beautiful spots in the Serra de Tramuntana. Its peak is crowned by a delightful sanctuary (XIV century) and a museum with small relics.

Walk to the Puig Santuiri:

The climb to the Puig de Santuiri (141m) is a very interesting walk, not only because of its panoramic views of the beautiful town of Pollença that lies at its feet but also because this route has a wide range of fascinating biodiversity including holm oak grove, garrigue and dwarf palms. There is plenty of wildlife to see, including the impressive black vulture.

Pollença Old town to Lluç Sanctuary

This is an easy and well-signposted route. It follows trails through outstanding countryside and has the imposing Lluç Sanctuary as a final reward. The first part is an easy stroll along country lanes and tracks, and thereafter it is a fairly steady climb. Much of the walk is on wide, well-defined tracks, and narrow dirt paths in the shade of holm oak woods.

There are plenty of opportunities to dip into Mallorca's rural history with examples of ruined charcoal burners' huts, ovens and silos and also an old lime kiln. Occasional glimpses through the woods give spectacular views of the surrounding mountains.

Pollença to Port Pollensa

This is a pleasant stroll for holidaymakers and hikers alike, and you can do it all year round. The path forms part of the dry stone route GR221 which enables the connection of the port all the way to the Town of Pollensa itself in around an hour and a half. The GR221 path is a well-signposted hiking route which covers over 150 kilometres of the Sierra Tramuntana mountains and is a very popular hike amongst tourists and residents.
